Directions and Parking Information

The Colloquium will be held at Temple University, Main Campus, which is located on North Broad Street, between Cecil B. Moore and Diamond Streets. The Tuttleman Learning Center is located on 13th St., between Montgomery Ave. and Berks St. For specific directions from your starting location use the following address with Mapquest or Google Maps:

General Driving Directions

From Bucks County / Northeast Philadelphia

Take I-95 south to exit 23 Girard Avenue. Follow Girard Ave. for 1.7 miles and make a right onto North 13th St. Follow 13th street north for 0.75 miles to Montgomery Ave.

From the Southeast Pennsylvania and Delaware

Take I-95 north to exit 22 for I-676 west. Once on I-676 west, immediately exit right onto Callowhill Street heading west. Follow Callowhill Street for 0.7 miles to North 13th Street. Make a right onto North 13th Street and go 1.5 miles to Montgomery Ave.

From New Jersey

* From all points south, take I-295 North to the 42/I-76 merge, take the I-76 West merge toward Philadelphia. Follow to the Walt Whitman Bridge/I-676 split, remain in the far right lanes for I-676. Continue with directions below.

* From all points north, take I-295 South to the 42/I-76 merge, take the I-76 West merge toward Philadelphia. Follow to the Walt Whitman Bridge/I-676 split, remain in the far right lanes for I-676. Continue with directions below.

* From all points East, take Route 322 or the Atlantic City Express to Route 42 North. Follow Route 42 to Bellmawr at which point it ends into I-76 West. Follow to the Walt Whitman Bridge/I-676 split, remain in the far right lanes for I-676. Continue with directions below.

Follow I-676 north to the Ben Franklin Bridge (toll). Cross the Ben Franklin Bridge, staying in the far right lane. At the foot of the bridge, immediately exit right onto Callowhill Street heading west. Follow Callowhill Street for 0.7 miles to North 13th Street. Make a right onto North 13th Street and go 1.5 miles to Montgomery Ave.

From New York / Northern New Jersey

Take the New Jersey Turnpike to exit 4 for Route 73 North. Proceed on Route 73 North to NJ 90 / Betsy Ross Bridge (toll). From the Betsy Ross Bridge take I-95 south for two miles to exit 23 Girard Avenue. Follow Girard Avenue for 1.7 miles and to Montgomery Ave.

Parking Information

On Saturdays, street parking is usually available within a block or two from Tuttleman Learning Center. Attendees may park in the nearby Liacouras Center parking garage on 15th Street between Cecil B. Moore St and Montgomery Ave. The cost for parking in the lot is \$12 for the entire day.

Public Transportation

Subway: Take the Broad Street Line (Orange Line) to Cecil B. Moore/ Temple University station.

Regional Rail: All regional rails except for the R6 Norristown/Cynwyd line stop at Temple University station, which is located on Berks St. between 10th and 9th Sts.

Route 23 Bus: The Route 23 travels north through Main Campus on 11th street from South and Center City Philadelphia and south on 12th street from Germantown and Mount Airy.
